For non-degree-seeking students

Our Level Up scholarship:

- Is for students in non-degree-seeking programs, classes or trainings that are up to 200 hours
- · Can also pay for tests, including LSAT, MCAT, GRE and GMAT
- Covers the actual course and/or testing cost (up to \$3,000 total)
- · Is awarded year-round
- · Is awarded on a first-come, first-served basis
- · Students are eligible to receive once per academic year

Who is eligible for a Level Up scholarship?

Level Up applicants must:

- Be enrolled to Doyon, Limited or be the child of an original enrollee
- · Be enrolled in a non-degree-seeking program that is up to 200 hours
- · Provide proof of academic enrollment, such as letter of acceptance
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.0 or provide certificate of completion with passing grade

What are non-degree-seeking programs?

Non-degree-seeking programs cover a wide range of areas, including real estate, leadership, CDL, maritime, continuing education and much more. These kinds of programs include certifications, trainings, licenses and even testing fees for the LSAT, MCAT, GRE and GMAT. If you have questions about eligible programs, please get in touch!

How do I apply?

The application process for non-degree-seeking students is the same as all other Foundation students. Applications are accepted online through the Foundation's scholarship portal at *doyonfoundation.com/apply*. Note that first-time applicants will need to create a new account, and that it can take up to three business days to verify a student's shareholder status.

What do I need to apply? For the Level Up scholarship, applicants must submit:

- · Completed online application
- · Signed release and consent form
- Original transcripts from the last school attended or GED scores
- Proof of academic enrollment (must show enrollment, cost of the course/training and credits received)



When is the application deadline?

Unlike our part-time, full-time and competitive awards, which have set deadlines, students can apply anytime during the year for a Level Up scholarship. Level Up scholarships are awarded year-round on a first-come, first-served basis, and students are eligible to receive one per academic year.
